Volunteer Regulations

Sign in and out at the front desk each time you volunteer, this process is in place to: track who is in the building in case of an emergency evacuation and keep a tally on how awesomely dedicated you are!

- Keep the Volunteer Coordinator informed on any changes to your schedule.
- Follow directions from LRHS staff.
- If you are unsure of something ask a staff member. If you feel uncomfortable doing something don't do it or ask for help.
- If you're sick or driving conditions are unsafe. Please stay home.
- Treat all customers, staff and volunteers with respect. Act professionally. Honor the confidentiality policy.

Dress Code

Wear closed-toed shoes with good traction and support. For your own safety, if you wear heels, flip flops or other dangerous footwear, you will be asked to change shoes before volunteering.

Wear pants whenever possible so that your legs are protected from scratches and scrapes.

Clothing should be free of profanity and should cover your entire belly, back, chest and shoulders.

Wear clothes that you do NOT care about, you will get dirty...we can guarantee you that!

Please refrain from wearing earbuds or anything that mutes your senses.
